HIGH HOLY DAYS CHILD SUPERVISION POLICY

Our intention is to keep your children safe and to make sure the atmosphere remains conducive to prayer and worship. To prevent disruptions from unsupervised children during the High Holy Day services, we have adopted the following policy regarding child supervision.

Children in 6th grade or below are expected to be either supervised by their parents or enrolled in the Camp Shofar program. **If they are not enrolled in the Camp Shofar program, children should be in the sanctuary with their parents.** Unsupervised children will not be allowed on the playground or to wander around the building. If your child is not enrolled in the Camp Shofar program, CBS staff and volunteers will NOT be responsible for your child's safety, whereabouts, or snacks. Unsupervised children found by the CBS staff or volunteers will be taken back to the sanctuary to their parents.

The Camp Shofar program is designed for children in 6th grade or below. All 7th graders and above are encouraged to participate with their parents during services and are invited to participate in Teen Services.

We thank you for supporting these important policies. We hope the High Holy Days bring a warm, safe and orderly environment for your family to enjoy.
